Terms and Conditions - Electric Forklift

Program Offer: The Program covers products purchased and/or services rendered on or after January 1, 2025.

Eligibility:

- Non-residential
- Purchase or lease a Class 1, 2, or 3 electric forklift(s) by December 31st, 2023
- Meet one of the following 3 requirements: Initial forklift, Addition to existing forklift(s), Replacement of an existing internal combustion forklift.
- Proper documentation is required: Invoice, Lease Agreement, Make, Model, and Year.
- Used Class 3 lifts are not eligible for rebate.

Rebate Amount:

- New Purchase: Forklift Class 1 or 2 \$1000, Class 3 \$350.
- Leased with purchase option: Same as new purchase rebate.
- Leased without purchase option,10-year max: Years of lease x10% of new purchase rebate.
- Purchase Used, Class 1 or 2: Discount New Rebate by \$100 for each year older.

General Terms and Conditions

Rebates shall be pro-rated based on the percent of power supplied by the utility if the customer has distributed generation.

Application Information: Missing or incorrect information on the application may delay processing and delivery of the rebate. Limitation of Liability: The Utility's liability in connection with this program is limited to paying the rebate specified when all terms and conditions have been satisfied. Under no circumstances shall the Utility be liable for any consequential or incidental damages or tax liability resulting from participation in this program.

Participant Certification: Participating Customer certifies that he/she purchased and installed the equipment listed on their application at the defined location served by the Utility. The Customer agrees that all information provided is true and that he/she has conformed to all program requirements. If the equipment and application does not comply with the Utility's rules and qualifications, the rebate amount may be denied or adjusted.
